

HOW CONTACT NORTH | CONTACT NORD IS SUPPORTING INDIGENOUS LEARNERS AND COMMUNITIES

1. Generates 3,316 student course registrations from learners using Contact North | Contact Nord online learning centres in Indigenous communities.

52% increase (+1,138 registrations) over 2019-2020

2. Has online learning centres in 23 Indigenous communities.

Three additional centres are scheduled to open in October 2021:

- Kettle and Stony Point First Nation
- Cat Lake First Nation
- Pikangikum First Nation

3. Does outreach in 126 Indigenous communities throughout Ontario.
4. Partners with Ontario's 9 Indigenous institutes to support local access to education and training for Indigenous learners.
5. Partners with Ontario Works and Employment Ontario offices in Indigenous communities to help their clients access education and training to get jobs.
